

Emacs Keybindings

The following notation is used in Emacs for keyboard shortcuts:

- ▶ C for <Ctrl>
- ▶ M for <Alt>
- ▶ '-' for when two keys are pressed together (e.g. C-x for <Ctrl>+x)
- ▶ SPC for <Space>
- ▶ RET for <Enter>

-
- ▶ Open a file: C-x C-f
TAB auto-completes, RET opens
 - ▶ Switch buffer: C-x b
Up/Down keys: browse buffers
 - ▶ Split view horizontally: C-x 2
 - ▶ Split view vertically: C-x 3
 - ▶ Switch between tabs: C-x o
 - ▶ Close current tab: C-x 0
 - ▶ Cut: C-w
 - ▶ Copy: M-w
 - ▶ Paste (yank): C-y
 - ▶ Compile section: C-c C-c
 - ▶ Compile whole file: C-c C-k

More Keybindings

- ▶ Cancel command mid-way: C-g
Or hit ESC 3 times.
- ▶ Kill buffer: C-x k
- ▶ Jump to definition: M-.
- ▶ Jump back from definition: M-,
- ▶ Select code within parentheses:
C-M-SPC
When at an opening parenthesis
- ▶ Exit Emacs: C-x C-c yes

While in the REPL

- ▶ Delete current input:
C-M-Backspace
- ▶ Get last command: C-UP
- ▶ Break line: C-j
